You're helping us to form good, holy priests who will work to save souls—which has always been, and will always be, the primary responsibility of any priest.

The priests of the FSSP have been doing this since our founding more than 30 years ago. And with your help, we'll continue to do so for decades to come.

#### BETTER MEN MAKE BETTER PRIESTS

As a supporter of the FSSP, you have probably had the chance to meet at least one of our priests—and perhaps you know many of them quite well. Whatever good they have done for you is a direct result of two things: the caliber of men we seek to form, and the manner in which we form them.

We seek men who have a strong sense of piety and sacrificial willingness to give themselves totally to our Lord Jesus Christ. Each man must also have a good reputation, moral aptitude, and intellectual ability. Once a man is accepted to our seminary, he will follow a well-tested, long-proven course of formation. Throughout their seven years of study, our men are immersed in the sound teachings, principles, and method of **St. Thomas Aquinas**, the Angelic Doctor of the Church.

Our men also live a life of constant prayer as St. Paul exhorted (1 Thess. 5:17). A normal day at our seminary begins with Lauds, meditation, and Mass. Prayers continue throughout the day and evening.

We believe this approach enables us to form the holiest and most capable men possible for Holy Mother Church. God willing, each of the men we are currently forming will someday serve at the altar and in the parish, so that the fullness of Christ might enter the emptiness of the world.

But as you can imagine, the cost of providing such a thorough formation is significant.

# WHAT IT TAKES TO PREPARE MEN FOR THE ALTAR

Everything worthwhile in this life comes at a steep cost. Despite our painstaking efforts to control expenses, it costs us \$30,000 per year to form each seminarian.

Because seminarians devote their lives to the pursuit of the holy priesthood, they of course

cannot earn the income necessary to offset the cost of their formation. We do ask each man to contribute \$7,000 per year towards tuition and living expenses, if possible, but not all are able.

The rest of the cost must be supplied by our generous friends—faithful Catholics like you.

With about \$23,000 to raise annually for each of our seminarians, our financial needs are very great indeed. But with God, nothing is impossible.

For example, if everyone reading this letter were to pledge just \$5 per month to our **Annual Fund Drive for Seminarian Support**, we would soon meet our fundraising goal!

Of course, not everyone will be able to give at this time. So I hope you will **consider a pledge** of \$25 or \$60 per month.

Perhaps you have been blessed with greater financial means. If so, I hope you'll be able to make a pledge of \$125 or \$250 per month. Such a generous gift would enable us to spend less time on finances and more time finding the best young men across the nation.

Of course, if you'd prefer to send a one-time gift rather than a monthly pledge, we would gratefully accept your contribution. **Gifts of \$2,500**, \$1,000, \$500, \$100, or whatever you can afford will immediately take us much closer to reaching our fundraising goal for 2019.
